The Luke Baldwin Award was established in memory of Dr. Luke Baldwin, who served as an associate professor, associate dean for academic affairs, and provost during his 15 years at Lesley. Dr. Baldwin came to Lesley as a faculty member in the Adult Baccalaureate program and was an advocate for adult learners throughout his career. Lesley University is proud to offer the Luke Baldwin Award each year to an adult student who has taken the risk to return to college to live Dr. Baldwin's ideal of lifelong learning and continued service to the community.

Erik Weihenmayer is an American athlete, adventurer, author, activist and motivational speaker, and is one of the most celebrated and accomplished athletes in the world. In 2001, he became the only blind person in history to climb Mount Everest. When he stood on the top of Carstensz Pyramid in 2008, he completed his quest to climb all of the Seven Summits—the tallest peak on each of the seven continents. Erik is the author of the best-selling memoir “Touch the Top of the World,” which was made into a feature film, as well as “The Adversity Advantage,” which shows readers how to turn everyday struggles into everyday greatness. His latest book, “No Barriers: A Blind Man’s Journey to Kayak the Grand Canyon,” is more than an adventure story; it illuminates how we move forward in our lives towards growth and purpose—despite the barriers. He is an internationally recognized speaker and brings his message of living a No Barriers Life to audiences around the world.

In September 2014, Erik and blinded Navy veteran Lonnie Bedwell kayaked the entire 277-miles of the Grand Canyon on the Colorado River, considered one of the most formidable whitewater venues in the world. Erik continually seeks out new adventures, focusing his efforts on empowering people traditionally swept to the sidelines of life. He founded an organization called No Barriers, which helps people with challenges tap into the human spirit, break through barriers, and contribute to the world.

Weihenmayer received his master’s degree in Education from Lesley University in 1993. While no longer a classroom teacher, he continues to educate and empower people through regular speaking engagements across and through No Barriers USA. He will speak at the morning ceremony for graduates of the Graduate School of Arts and Social Sciences and Graduate School of Education as well as at the afternoon ceremony for graduates of the College of Liberal Arts and Sciences and the College of Art and Design and students completing the Threshold Program.

Award of Honors: Because of publication deadlines, the honors listed in this program are based on students' cumulative grade point averages of all completed coursework as of April 28, 2023, and may not include the names of those who earn honors once final grades are posted to students' official academic records. Academic Regalia

The academic attire worn at Commencement has its origins in the Middle Ages. The purpose of academic regalia is to display the academic and scholarly achievements of the wearer. From the cap, gown, and academic hood it is possible to distinguish the institution from which the wearer graduated, the field of learning in which his or her degree was earned, and the level of degree.

Academic hoods are the visual representation of scholastic degrees. Academic hoods are lined with the official color of the college or university conferring the degree, and the velvet detail represents the learning discipline. All Lesley University academic hoods are green and gold and the following colors represent each discipline:

Arts: White

Education: Light Blue

Fine Arts: Brown

Science: Golden Yellow

The honorary academic hoods are white for Doctor of Humane Letters and brown for Doctor of Fine Arts.

The mortarboard hats and soft velvet tams are black. Prior to receiving the degree, the tassel is worn on the right. The graduates ceremonially turn the tassel to the left at the end of the Commencement ceremony.

Gowns are normally black, and the level of the degree is indicated by the cut of the gown. Colored doctoral gowns represent the school colors of the college or university that awarded the doctoral degree. The green gowns of the president, trustees, and honorary degree recipients represent the Lesley University colors. The president wears the Lesley University presidential medallion.

Cords worn by graduates of the College of Art and Design and the College of Liberal Arts and Sciences indicate honors. Summa Cum Laude cords are gold, Magna Cum Laude cords are gold and white, and Cum Laude cords are white.
